Attendance Policy

Please note that 85% attendance is mandatory for all students. Students of Grades 6 to 8 will be required to attend classes on two working Saturdays each month. In case of medical leave exceeding two days, parents are requested to submit supporting medical documents. For leave requests due to medical or other reasons, kindly email the Principal at principal-blk@presidency.edu.in , with a copy marked to the COD and the class teacher.

To ensure that classes commence on time, the school gates will close at 8:00 a.m. Parents are requested to ensure that their ward reaches the school before 7:55 a.m. Any interaction with members of the school staff may be scheduled only through prior appointments on working Saturdays.

Norms and Guidelines

- Student norms and guidelines are clearly outlined in the Student Handbook.
- Students are required to wear the regular school uniform on Mondays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, all working Saturdays, and during all PTM days. The sports uniform must be worn on Tuesdays and Fridays.

Parents are requested to ensure that their child reports to school in a neat, tidy, and well-maintained uniform at all times. Boys should maintain a regular haircut, and girls with long hair are expected to keep it neatly plaited and tied with black hair band.

Parents are encouraged to ensure that all notebooks and textbooks are properly



covered and clearly labelled.
